Development of the information security system of the FBS of Russia

IFB Number: JSSP/ICB/2.7.5.

1. The Russian Federation has received a loan from the New Development Bank (NDB) toward the cost of Judicial System Support Project, and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this loan to payments under the agreement resulting from this IFB: JSSP/ICB/2.7.5 “Development of the information security system of the FBS of Russia”.
2. Foundation for Enterprise Restructuring and Financial Institutions Development (FER), which is authorized by Federal Bailiff Service (FBS) to conduct the bidding and subsequently sign the contract as a Payer with the selected Supplier, now invites sealed bids from eligible Bidders for improvement of FBS information security system, including:
 - Supply of goods for development of FBS information security system;
 - Compliant with the requirements;
 - Provision of services for development of working documentation;
 - Installation services;
 - Provision of warranty services.
3. Bidding will be conducted using the International Competitive Bidding (ICB) procedures specified in the World Bank’s Guidelines: Procurement under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits, edition of January 2011, revised July 2014, and principles of NDB Procurement Policy (2018, as amended from time to time) and is open to all eligible bidders in the NDB member countries, that meet the following minimum qualification criteria:

(a) Financial Capabilities

(1) The Bidder’s (single Bidder or Joint Venture) average annual turnover shall be at least USD **7,000,000** (or an equivalent amount in a different currency) for the last 3 years (2019–2021).

If the Bidder is a Joint Venture, the average annual turnover of the Partner in charge shall be at least USD **5,000,000** (or an equivalent amount in a different currency) for the last 3 years (2019–2021). The average annual turnover of each Partner in a Joint Venture shall be at least equivalent of USD **2,000,000** for the last 3 years (2019-2021).

b) Specific Experience with Similar Projects

(1) The Bidder shall furnish documentary evidence to demonstrate that during the last three years (2019-2021) the Bidder must have successfully completed one or more IT equipment supply and installation contracts (servers, storage systems, routers, switches, data protection hardware and software) for the total amount of at least USD **3,000,000**.

Where the Bidder is a Joint Venture, the Partner in Charge must comply with this requirement.

(2) The Bidder shall furnish documentary evidence to demonstrate that during the last three years (2018-2020) the Bidder must have successfully completed one or more contracts for the supply and installation of information security hardware (firewalls, VPN gateways,

intrusion detection systems (IPS/ISD, traffic analysis systems (DPI)) and/or information security software (anti-virus, software based VPN gateways, software based firewalls, traffic analysis software systems) for the total amount of at least USD **1,000,000**. The required experience could be demonstrated as part of the larger contracts for implementation of information systems.

Where the Bidder is a Joint Venture, the Partner in Charge must comply with this requirement.

c) Technical (Organizational) Capacities

(1) The Bidder (or, if the Bidder is a Joint Venture, all partners of Joint Venture) shall be certified under ISO 9001.

(2) The Bidder (or, if the Bidder is a Joint Venture, any member of Joint Venture) or its authorized subcontractor shall have FSTEC license for technical protection of confidential information for the following works and services:

- Certification tests and certification for compliance with the requirements for protection of information in:
 - IT tools and systems.
- Secure design of:
 - IT tools and systems.
- Installation, assembly, adjustment, testing, repair of information security tools:
 - Information security software (software and hardware);
 - Secure information processing software (software and hardware);
 - Information security control software (software and hardware);

(3) The Bidder (or, if the Bidder is a Joint Venture, any member of Joint Venture) or its authorized subcontractor shall have FSC license for the development, production, distribution of encryption (cryptographic) tools, information and telecommunication systems protected with the use of encryption (cryptographic) tools, performance of works, provision of services in the area of encryption of information, maintenance of encryption (cryptographic) tools, information and telecommunication systems protected with the use of encryption (cryptographic) tools (except where the maintenance of encryption (cryptographic) tools, information and telecommunication systems protected with the use of encryption (cryptographic) tools is performed for the own needs of a legal entity or an individual entrepreneur) with regard to the following works and services:

- Assembly, installation, adjustment of encryption (cryptographic) tools, except for encryption (cryptographic) tools for fiscal data protection, developed for the use as part of cash register equipment, certified by the Federal Security Service of the Russian Federation.
- Maintenance of encryption (cryptographic) tools as provided for in the technical and operational documentation for these tools (except where such works are performed for the own needs of a legal entity or an individual entrepreneur).
- Transfer of encryption (cryptographic) tools, except for encryption (cryptographic) tools for fiscal data protection, developed for the use as part of cash register equipment, certified by the Federal Security Service of the Russian Federation.

4. Interested eligible Bidders may obtain further information from FER and inspect the bidding documents at the address given below from 10:00 till 18:00 Moscow time.

5. A complete set of Bidding Documents in English and Russian languages may be purchased by interested bidders on the submission of a written Application to the address below.

The application for the bidding documents must state the following information: a) the name of the potential Bidder, b) the address to which the bidding documents should be sent, c) the telephone and fax numbers, d) a statement that the requested bidding document is for Contract JSSP/ICB/2.7.5 “Development of the information security system of the FBS of Russia”, and e) the potential Bidder’s preferred mode of delivery of the bidding documents. Any information regarding the bidding process will be sent to the person and address of the potential Bidder in accordance with information in the application for the bidding documents.

Upon receipt of the written application one set of the bidding documents will be sent by airmail for overseas delivery and surface mail for local delivery. Alternatively, if specifically requested by the potential Bidder, the FER will send the bidding documents by courier service at the expense of the potential Bidder. In such a case, the potential Bidder must supply the appropriate courier name and account number for its chosen courier service. Potential Bidders may choose to arrange courier pick-up of the bidding documents at the office of the FER specified below. These methods for obtaining the documents should be coordinated with the contact person named below

6. Bids must be delivered to the address below at or before 14:00 Moscow time July 4, 2022. Bids need to be secured by a bid security. The amount of Bid Security required is USD 55,000.00 or an equivalent amount in the currency of Bid, or an equivalent amount in a freely convertible currency or in Russian Rubles. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened in the presence of Bidders’ representatives who choose to attend at the address below at 14:00 Moscow time July 4, 2022.
7. The attention of prospective Bidders is drawn to (i) the fact that they will be required to certify in their bids that all software is either covered by a valid license or was produced by the Bidder and (ii) that violations are considered fraud, which is, among other remedies, punishable by potential blacklisting from participation in future NDB-financed procurement.
